



Bulk Policy

Bulk Pick-up details: All customers receive one bulk pick-up per month as part of our residential trash service. Bulk routes are ran on Wednesdays, and each route is assigned a specific Wednesday (1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th Wednesday of the month). Requests for pick-ups must be submitted no later than Tuesday 4 PM before the scheduled bulk route. Bulk items must be out by the road by 6 AM on pick-up day. Don't know your Wednesday? Call or email us!

Bulk Rules:

Monthly Bulk Pick-up details:

*If an item can be placed by the trash can, is under 50 lbs., and can be safely loaded in our compactor trucks, then it is not a bulk pick-up item and should be put out with normal residential trash.

*Any single monthly bulk pick-up is limited to 250 lbs.

*Items included in a bulk pick-up include standard household debris such as: furniture (excluding sleeper sofas and loveseats and couches with reclining mechanisms), TV's, toilets, mattresses, appliances, limbs and other minor yard debris**.

**Limbs must be neatly stacked in small piles manageable by a single employee not more than 4 feet in length. Individual limbs must be less than 6 inches in diameter.

Bulk pick-up ***excludes*** the following items:

Hazardous waste such as fluorescent bulbs, tires, paint, oils or other liquids, lumber or construction debris of any type including tubs, flooring (including carpet), fencing, decking, and siding, riding lawn mowers, sleeper sofas, and loveseat and couches with reclining mechanisms. Special Pick-up details: For customers requiring immediate service (cannot wait until the scheduled bulk day) or service for items not qualifying for bulk pick-up, a Special Pick-up Service is available. Special Pick-up Service is \$75 up to 500 lbs. Items included are: all items permitted for bulk service, sleeper sofas, loveseats and couches with reclining mechanisms, lumber or construction debris, and riding lawn mowers. Small items must be bagged. This special service is usually available in 2 business days or less.

Residential Dumpsters: Sometimes you have more trash than the options above can accommodate. Any needs in excess of the above may be best met by our residential dumpster. These 11-yard dumpsters are available at a discount to Adams Sanitation customers and can hold up to 10,000 lbs. Notes on Hazardous Waste:

Hazardous Waste: Hazardous waste doesn't belong in landfills, and these items must be kept out of your trash can. How do you dispose of them? Okaloosa County accepts these items for free at 1759 S. Ferdon Blvd. in Crestview. Call 850-301-2013 before you go to ensure they are open. Items they accept include but are not limited to: paints, pesticides, used oil, oil filters, pool chemicals, batteries, gas, solvents, paint products, tar, automotive chemicals, fluorescent bulbs, smoke alarms, fire extinguishers, and computer monitors. Got old cell phones and batteries? We can collect them at our office! These rechargeable batteries are collected: Lithium ion, nickel cadmium, nickel metal hydride, and small sealed lead acid. We also accept small single use batteries including AA, AAA, 9V, C, D, and button cell batteries. Small hand-held electronics with integrated rechargeable batteries such as cell phones, are also

accepted. This service is limited to a maximum of 2 lbs of batteries per customer per month.
